All speakers were given 20 mins of speech highlighting the merits and demerits of the recently adopted Forest (Conservation) Amendment Act (FCAA) 2023. The FCAA was adopted by the Ninth Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in August 2025 igniting huge debate over the act. The speakers and panellists of the second series of talk emphasize the point of clash with Article 371G of the Indian Constitution as well as merits part of the act.
