01.03 Follow-up action on the Minutes of the Minutes of 3rd Meeting of IQAC:

01.06 Presentation on 10 NAAC Attribute Wise Data:

Representatives of the 10 NAAC attribute-wise teams made brief presentations to the IQAC on preparation, collection and compilation of data on their respective attributes.

01.07 Remarks and Recommendations from the Members:

The members appreciated the efforts by the NAAC attribute-wise teams and provided several valuable suggestions. It was recommended that the SWOT analysis be refined to reflect institutional strengths and limitations, rather than just systemic issues, and that specific interventions for improving internal infrastructure be included. Emphasis was placed on addressing the physical infrastructure needs in light of regional and demographic diversity, with a call for designs that are environmentally sustainable, inclusive, and resilient. The importance of supporting findings with relevant data, such as from the AISHE portal, was also noted. Suggestions were made to include

more specificity in the funding mechanisms and planning frameworks, along with examples or models for financing infrastructure development. The need for state-specific strategies, case studies of best practices, and adoption of green and smart campus models was stressed. Members underscored the importance of establishing strong monitoring and evaluation mechanisms for implementation. They also highlighted the need to link infrastructure planning directly to learning outcomes and academic performance, advocating for inclusive design principles that consider gender, disability, and socio-economic diversity. Furthermore, it was advised to adopt participatory planning approaches involving students and faculty, and to integrate digital infrastructure with physical planning while ensuring long-term maintenance and sustainability.

It was also suggested by the members to make detail attribute wise report for the next meeting based on the Binary Accreditation Framework Metrics for University Manual which will be shared with the IQAC.
